IN THE NAME AND AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Detective A. de la Rosa #2801 who after being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that heretofore to wit: on or about the 14th day of December 2022 and before the filing of this complaint in the County of El Paso, the State of Texas, one Kevin Joe Robles, Hereinafter called the DEFENDANT, did then and there unlawfully, intentionally, knowingly, causes the death of the individual (victim- Juan Julian Macias Salas 01/27/1941; grandfather to the defendant; 81 year old male);

This incident occurred in the city and county of El Paso, Texas;

PC:

On December 14, 2022 Crimes Against Persons detectives were called out by Sgt. Chavez #2063 in reference to EPPD case #22-348012.

EPPD Patrol officers responded to a 911 call placed by the defendant's father (Jaime Robles) regarding an aggravated assault with a knife. The defendant's father stated to the 911 dispatcher that defendant asked him to pick him up at a nearby convenience store because he had attacked the victim. The defendant, his parents and the victim all reside in the same residence together.

Fire Medical Services and EPPD officers arrive to the residence of the incident and the victim was found without signs of life. The victim had blood on his face and neck with a possible stab wound to the neck.

Detectives spoke to Jaime Robles and Francis Robles (parents to defendant) for sworn statements. Jamie Robles stated that he received a phone call from a unknown number and stated that it was the defendant asking him for a ride home. Jaime Robles advised that the defendant told him that he attacked the victim with a knife and wanted help. The parents of the defendant did not know that he had left the residence during the night. Jamie Robles stated that when they arrived back home he observed the victim with blood on his face and neck and called 911.

The affiant and Det. Carreon #2929 conducted a formal interview with the defendant who stated that he was feeling agitated in the middle of the night and sandpapered a fork into a knife. The defendant stated that he was hearing voices telling him to kill someone or to kill himself. The defendant stated that during his agitation he went into the victim's room and "laid hands on him". The defendant stated that he used a fork instead of a knife because he did not want the wound to be too big.


